



Draft implementation road map 2023–2030 for the global action plan for the prevention and control of noncommunicable diseases 2013–2030

Thank you Chair, honourable members, distinguished delegates.

IAPO represents interests of 1 million patients through 300 direct member organizations and over 2000 members of our member organisation alliances.

IAPO recommends that the Member States implement the WHO Global Patient Safety Action Plan 2021-30 (GPSAP 2021-30) Decision WHA74(13) in toto in all noncommunicable diseases control programmes and settings, especially in large scale health emergencies, and within the draft recommendations on how to strengthen the design and implementation of policies, including those for resilient health systems and health.

IAPO also recommends that GPSAP 2021-30 be adopted in all mental healthcare settings to control suicides, self-harm, medication errors, coercive care, violence, and self-harm.

GPSAP ensures compassionate and safe patient co-produced humanised healthcare for all
